

Beating the Bounds Sunday 21 May 2017

This is the third year for Veryan's 'Beating the Bounds' event.

Determined (and fit!) walkers and runners will tackle the whole route but we are hoping that a good number of us will walk the third section, from HAY BARTON TO WEST PORTHOLLAND.

Much of this section of the boundary adjoins the parishes of Cuby and St Michael Caerhays.

The route

This section is around 5-6 miles (up to 3 hours' walking) and takes us mainly across privately owned farmland, rather than public footpaths. Consequently there may be stock in some fields and the terrain can be uneven. It will be clearly marked and maps will be provided. It is essential that we keep to the marked and agreed route.

NB STOUT WALKING FOOTWEAR PLEASE, AND WE CANNOT ALLOW ANY DOGS ON THIS SECTION.

Times

Whole route: walkers leave West Portholland 8 am, runners 1.30 pm

From Pendower: walkers start at 11 am, runners at 2.45 pm

HAY TO PORTHOLLAND WALKERS meet at Hay Barton by 1pm for home-made pasties and sandwiches

and leave at 1.30 pm aiming to reach West Portholland at 5 pm.(tea and cakes!)
